What do you do when you read a really good book? You want to tell people about it. You tell them they should read it. Maybe you know how hard it can be not to talk about a good book to a friend who has not read the book yet. You want to tell your friend what the book is about, but you do not want to ruin it by saying too much. If you love to talk about good books, it is a good idea to join a book club. But it's important to choose one that matches you.

One of the great things is in a book club, everyone decides together on a book to read. Then everyone reads it at the same speed. When everyone has finished the book, you can get together and discuss it. This way, everyone has read the book, so you do not have to worry about saying too much. There's no need to worry about spoiling the story, or not understanding the conversations. The way people understand stories is often different between each person. Joining a book club is a great way to meet new people with many ways of thinking.

But, it's important to join a book club that has similar interests to you. Being in a club with similar types of book interests is important. If you aren't interested in the book that is being discussed, you won't enjoy it. Also, making sure that everyone reads at the same speed as you (<u>b</u>) do. If everyone reads at a different pace, you won't want to go to the meetings because you haven't finished the book yet. Having a group of people who enjoy similar books makes reading more enjoyable.
