This machine shoots a strong light at the captain of the ship. When the light hits him, the captain falls down, asleep. The other members of the ship ① [him / wake / to / try / up / but] they cannot. They don't know what is happening to their captain.

When the captain wakes up, he is in a house, and a kind woman tells him she is his wife. He has been sick (㍻) a few days and is finally awake. She says his name is Kamin and that they live in a small town. The captain does not believe her, and he tries to find a way to contact his ship. But this world does not have spaceships or advanced technology, so he realizes he cannot leave.

The captain slowly accepts his new life as Kamin. He spends time with his wife and begins to love her very much. He makes a close friend in the town and learns how to play the flute. He becomes very good at it and enjoys playing old folk songs. He works in his town and watches the stars. Eventually, he and his wife have two children, a boy and a girl. Kamin sees his children grow up, and he sees them have children, too. He and his wife grow old together. He forgets that he was ever the captain of a spaceship.

② [_____], something is wrong with the world Kamin and his people live on. Every year, it becomes hotter, and there is less and less rain. The sun is dying. Soon, it will become too big and explode, and their whole world will be gone. There is nothing they can do to stop it. Kamin and his people are very sad, but they try to live their lives fully.

Kamin became an old man, and his friend and wife died years ago. ③ One day, his children and grandchildren want him to come see a special event. The leaders of the world are shooting a new rocket (㍿) space. Kamin doesn't know what the rocket is, but he goes to watch. Suddenly, his close friend and wife are standing in front of him. They are smiling and happy to see him. They tell him that their world died 1,000 years ago. The rocket carries their memories, and they hoped it would find someone in the future that could see their memories and teach others (㍺) their world.

At this moment, Kamin remembers everything. ④ He remembers being captain of the spaceship and seeing the strange machine and light. He understands that the rocket is the strange machine, and it will find him 1,000 years in the future.

His life as Kamin was really a message (お) a lost world.

Back on the spaceship, the captain starts to wake up. He looks (か) the other members of the ship and slowly remembers their names. He asks how long he's ⑤ [be] asleep, and they tell him 25 minutes. Friendship

True friends want to see you grow, succeed, and become your best self. But it's important to remember that you shouldn't take advantage of them. This means expecting them to put more into a friendship than you do. You should give as much as you take in a good friendship. This is the most important thing. The first step to having good friends is being a good friend yourself.

On the other hand, not all friendships are positive. Some people may try to pressure you to do things you know are wrong, such as skipping school, lying, or talking badly about others. These kinds of friendships can cause stress or make you feel uncomfortable. If you notice that spending time with someone makes you feel worried, guilty, or less confident, it might be a sign that the friendship is unhealthy. These types of friendships can lead to both physical and mental issues. You don't always have to end the friendship suddenly, but you can choose to spend less time together or talk honestly about how you feel.

Making new friends can take time, and that's okay. Some people are shy or afraid to start conversations, but even small steps can help. Smiling, asking simple questions, and joining clubs or activities you enjoy are great ways to meet new people. When you share interests, it's easier to build real connections. Remember, friendship is not about having many people around you; it's about having people who truly care.

In the end, good friends can make your life happier, more meaningful, and full of positive experiences. Choosing friends wisely and being a good friend in return can help you grow into the kind of person you want to be.
